Homeless Veteran Burial Program Marks 15 Years of Service to Veterans

HOUSTON, July 1, 2015 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- Service Corporation International (NYSE:SCI) and its brand Dignity Memorial, the U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, along with local government agencies have utilized their resources for the past 15 years to honor 1600 forgotten heroes through the SCI Dignity Memorial Homeless Veterans Burial program.

The program provides identification, preparation, transportation, clothing, casket and coordination of a full military honors funeral service. Eligible veterans also receive the opening and closing of the gravesite, a grave liner, a headstone or marker, a graveside ceremony and burial in a national cemetery.

"Through the program, homeless and indigent veterans who have no family are identified and provided with a proper military burial," says Michael R. Webb, SCI's Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer.

"Nearly 1.5 million veterans are at risk of becoming homeless and going hungry. I'm proud that SCI and Dignity Memorial provide comfort to those who have served our country."
