## SCI Scholarship Program Recognizes Mortuary Students From Across the Country

"SCI is honored to support the next generation of funeral service professionals," said Phil Sprick, Senior Managing Director of Human Resources at SCI. "Their compassion, dedication and enthusiasm for serving families are the skills needed to lead and be successful in our industry."

Since the program's inception in 2011, SCI has awarded over \$300,000 in mortuary scholarships. In addition, several past winners have secured positions as funeral directors, funeral attendants and apprentices at SCI's Dignity Memorial locations across the country.
